

FIRST AID CONVENTION IN EUROPE

COMPETITION EQUIPMENT LIST

At the FACE Competition this year, an AED will form part of the equipment used at the Competition Stations. The AED being used is the Defibtech Training Unit. This will be supplied by the Slovenian Red Cross and will form part of the Scenario. Training in the use of this AED will be given to each team prior to the competition during the Convention.

Other equipment must be supplied by each team and can only comprise of the following:

Equipment

Pocket face mask/airway barrier device – a minimum of 1 per team member and leader

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| - Disposable gloves for all members at each Station | - Polythene bags |
| - Wound dressings | - Water |
| - Triangular bandages | - Blankets – may be foil/fleece but not heavy wollen blankets. Only 1 per team member (maximum is 6 per team) |
| - Crepe/conforming bandages | - Cotton Wool |
| - Tape or safety pins | - Paramedic Shears / Scissors with 2 rounded sides |
| - Gauze | - Note pad and pen |
| - Assorted small adhesive dressings | |

Optional items:

- Pen torch
- Torch
- Sugar/candy
- Labels

These items can be reused if their condition is still clean after the Station is complete.

This list is the full list of all equipment which any team may use at any station for FACE 2016. Use of other equipment (including pre-made splints, neck collars, or other items) may lead to disqualification from a station or a reduction in marks allocated for that station.
